




# Cub Scout Pack 116 Uniform Requirements

<p>"Class A" Uniform Shirt</p>	<p><u>Lion, Tiger, Wolf, Bear</u>: Blue</p> <p><u>Webelos, Arrow of Light</u>: Khaki</p> <p><i>Unless otherwise specified, the Class A uniform should be worn to all Den and Pack meetings and events.</i></p> <p><i>Plan to buy your shirt a size or 2 bigger than you need for room to grow in upcoming years. The khaki shirt carries over to Scouts BSA.</i></p>

**Where can I buy all this stuff?**

The Scout Shop is located at 1061 N. Dobson Road #109, Mesa, AZ 85201. You also can buy most of these items on [www.scoutstuff.org](http://www.scoutstuff.org), but we recommend buying the Class A shirt at the Scout Shop so your Scout can try it on.

### **The official Scout pants are expensive. Are there alternatives?**

Yes. We recommend cargo-style pants or shorts; blue for a blue uniform shirt, green for a khaki shirt. Jeans also are fine for most events and activities. Scouts should not wear athletic apparel with their Class A uniforms because there is no place to wear a belt and display belt loop awards.

The Class A shirt must be tucked in at all times and should always be worn with a rank-appropriate neckerchief.

### **How do I attach patches to the uniform shirt?**

Sewing them on is best. The Scout Shop will sew on patches for \$3/patch, but the main customer service person is self-professed not a sewing expert. Some have used a product called Patch Magic, but patches may fall off after several washings and will leave a residue once removed.
